

## **CCPRO Executive Board Meeting Minutes**

**April 11, 2001  
Asheville, NC**

The last meeting of the North Carolina Community College Planning and Research Organization (CCPRO) was held on April 11 at its annual conference in Asheville, NC, April 9-11, 2001. The meeting was called to order by Past President Dave White, who was officiating in the absence of incoming President Lynne Bunch.

Dr. White announced that the Asheville Conference had proven very successful due to the hard work of those on the executive committee, those making presentations, and all those attending. He introduced the new CCPRO officers for 2001-2002: President Lynne Bunch, VP College Advancement, College of the Albermarle; President Elect Betty Wilson, Director of Institutional Effectiveness, Edgecombe Community College; Secretary Polly Davis, Director of Planning and Research, Fayetteville Technical Community College; Treasurer Tom Mustillo, Coordinator, Evaluation and Research, Durham Technical Community College. Dave, Director of Research and Planning, Asheville-Buncombe Technical Community College, will remain on the Board as CCPRO's Past President.

Betty Wilson presented the Treasurer's Report and thanked all of those who devoted their time to making the Conference a success. She reported on the progress of CCPRO's new president, Lynne Bunch, and asked that the CCPRO membership keep her in their thoughts and prayers.

Thanks went to Tom Mustillo and Evelyn Kientz, who produced the Conference Program. Appreciation was extended to Phyllis Cagle, Research Technician for the Asheville-Buncombe President, and to Amy Harris, Secretary for Planning and Institutional Effectiveness at Beaufort County Community College, who staffed the registration table during the entire conference. Phyllis also was praised for her assistance with the membership list/booklet and for printing the program. Farewells were issued to Dr. Ron Caplette and Dave Slagle, who will be retiring, and to Evelyn Kientz, who is moving into another position at her college.

Dave announced that the executive committee is investigating sites for the CCPRO Conference in 2002 and would appreciate any suggestions.

Keith Brown gave the latest information from NCCCS concerning the budget deficit facing all colleges in the state. He lamented that travel funds would be scarce for the remainder of the year. He also updated attendees on the NCCCS Performance Measures and Standards and the planned date for their publication. With no further business, door prizes were dispersed, and the meeting was adjourned at 12:00 p.m.
